





## QUICK EXPRESS DESIGN

This project is a very quick example of how to create an express embroidery design from a piece of clip art.

1. Start 4D Extra.
2. On the top menu bar, select Hoop . Use the drop down arrow next to Hoop Group and choose the Pfaff Creative Vision. Use the drop down arrow next to 360mm x 200mm – Creative Deluxe Hoop. Orientation = Horizontal. (If hoop options are grayed out so that you can't select a hoop size, uncheck the Enter Hoop Size box).
3. Select Express Design Wizard  from the top menu bar.
4. Choose Create Express Embroidery, Next.
5. View Picture  and Browse  to the folder C:\4DEmbroidery\Samples\4DEmb\Pics2\Fashion. Left click once on 1CFa05.png to select it as the image you wish to convert to an embroidery design. Choose Next.
6. Rotate Picture window: choose Next.
7. Crop Picture window: choose Next.
8. Reduce Colors window: choose Next.
9. Choose Thread Colors window: put a check mark in the Automatically Remove Background Colors box and then select the Remove All Background Color Areas button. Choose Next.
10. On the Fabric and Stitch Type Options window, choose Next.
11. On the final window, choose Finish.

There are many different options you could select along the way to have a more customized project, but this gives a very quick example of how to use a clip-art image to obtain a beautiful embroidery design in about 1 minute! This is where the 4D Embroidery software absolutely shines in its simplicity!
